# AGREEMENT

## Help create a lasting legacy at Marcus Oldham.

**THE MOC HERD**  
**Marcus Oldham Cattle Club**

to **MARCUS OLDHAM COLLEGE** of 145 Pigdons Road, Waurnd Ponds, Victoria.

1. In consideration of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ paid by the College to the farmer. The farmer agrees with the College each year for a period of six years from the date of this agreement without cost to the College;
  - a) To cause his cattle to bear progeny each year
  - b) Either to sell one steer calf from the progeny of his cattle and pay the net proceeds of sale to the College as a donation or to pay the College the agreed market value of one steer calf from the progeny of his cattle being the average market value of the sale by him of steer calves for that year
  - c) To care for his cattle and their progeny in accordance with the principles of good animal husbandry and to bear all costs of agistment, fee, vaccination, drenching, veterinary services and other costs
2. The farmer agrees that the property and ownership in the cattle and their progeny shall remain with him and he shall be responsible for their maintenance
3. At the expiration of six years from the date of this agreement the farmer shall be discharged from all obligations under this agreement and the cow is the property of the breeder.
