Interviews for shortlisted applicants will be conducted by phone in the week commencing Monday 15 September 2008 and applicants **shortlisted** for interview will be advised in the week prior to interview date.

Successful applicants must accept the verbal offer of the scholarship offer by fax or email within 48 hours of notification, and pay the scholarship acceptance fee of **A\$2,000** by the date nominated in the scholarship offer document - usually within 14 days. This will allow the College to complete visa application documentation.
